On August 22, 2014, NACHA's Voting Membership approved nine amendments to the *NACHA Operating Rules (Rules):*

- ACH Network Risk and Enforcement
- Improving ACH Network Quality Unauthorized Entry Fee
- Clarification of Audit Requirements for Participating DFIs Reporting Network Administration
 Fees
- Point-of-Sale (POS) Entries Clarification of General Rule
- Return Fee Entry Formatting Requirements
- Entry Detail Record for Returns Clarification Regarding Point of Purchase (POP) Entries
- Clarification of RDFI's Obligation to Recredit Receiver
- Clarification on Prenotification Entries and Addenda Records
- Clarification on Company Identification for P2P WEB (Internet-Initiated/Mobile) Credit Entries

The effective dates of these changes span from August 22, 2014 through October 3, 2016. Please see each amendment for further information on its effective date.

Supplement #2-2014 also contains the 2015 ACH Network Administration Fees as approved by NACHA's Board of Directors. The new fee schedule is effective January 1, 2015.

This supplement provides ACH Network participants with a summary of the key components of each change, along with details regarding the technical changes to the *Rules* language.
